## PRIVACY ACT STATEMENT

Authority: The collection of this information is authorized under 5 U.S.C. 301 (Departmental regulations), 5 U.S.C. 552a (Records maintained on individuals); 15 U.S.C. 1512 (Powers and duties of Department), 44 U.S.C. 2904 (General responsibilities for records management) and the Department's and NOAA's programmatic authorities including the Global Change Research Act, 15 U.S.C. 2936.
